Baptism:

1. What is the method of baptism most biblical?
2. When in the life of a believer is baptism performed?

Spiritual Gifts / Cessationism:

1. Are miraculous spiritual gifts for today?
2. Which spiritual gifts are no longer used today?
3. Are the “tongues” mentioned in Acts 2 the same tongues mentioned in 1 Corinthians?
4. Is “Speaking in tongues” THE sign of Spirit Baptism?
5. How does one ‘discover’ his or her spiritual gifts?

Salvation:

1. How exactly does a person become born again?
2. Is it possible for a true believer to fall away and go to hell?

Return of Christ:

1. When in history will Jesus return?
2. Is the ‘rapture’ before or after the tribulation?
3. Is the ‘rapture’ before or after the millennial reign of Christ?
4. Are Jews and Gentiles on separate tracks of salvation beginning with the rapture and millennium?

Church and Communion:

1. Is communion for believers or unbelievers?
2. At what age can someone begin taking communion?
3. What exactly are the qualifications for serving as a Pastor or Elder?
4. How are church officers selected in the New Testament Church?
5. Are there “Apostles” alive today?
6. Is there any evidence that church attendance or church membership is mandatory or important?
7. Are churches supposed to meet on Saturday (sabbath)?
8. Is there any evidence for the doctrine of purgatory?
9. Can women serve as church leaders? (which ones?)

God:

1. Is the Holy Spirit a person or a force?
2. Is Jesus eternal or was he created?

Christian Conduct

1. Is it permissible for people to live together before marriage?
2. Can a Christian date or marry an unbeliever?
3. Is homosexuality really forbidden in the scriptures?
4. Is it possible to be born in wrong body? (transsexual)
5. What are specific disciplines that Christians are called to regularly practice? (how often??)

Note: you are not limited to these questions. However, notice that these questions are straight forward and can be answered easily by bible passages without conjecture or speculation.
